2008 Drought Watch

Prognosis: Optimistic

The two major rain events of January have contributed to the steady rise of Lake Cachuma. Storage in the Lake as of January 28th was about 179,086 acre feet (AF). When storage drops to about 100,000 AF the five Cachuma member units - Carpinteria Valley, Montecito, Goleta and Santa Ynez Water Districts along with the City of Santa Barbara - begin discussions about reducing their use of Cachuma Water to prolong the life of the remaining supply. The Lake begins to spill when storage reaches about 188,000 AF. The member agencies are entitled to and usually take an average of 25,000 AF per year from the Lake. Carpinteria Valley Water District normally provides between 4,100 and 4,500 AF/year to its customers and relies on the Lake for up to 2,800 AF/year.

The rainy season officially continues for another couple of months, so optimism is the current prognosis.

It Could Spill This Year!!!

Cachuma Reservoir is one facet of the entire Cachuma Project, which also includes Bradbury Dam, the Tecolote Tunnel and the South Coast Conduit. Construction of Bradbury Dam and Cachuma Lake portions of the project began in August 1950 and ended in June 1953. The first water deliveries to Carpinteria occurred in 1955.

The Cachuma Project's construction was motivated by a desire to capture and store the floodwaters of the Santa Ynez River to ensure a more dependable water source for agricultural and municipal customers in South Santa Barbara County. Many opponents to the project thought the reservoir would never fill and that it would be a dry lake. Contrary to this belief, Cachuma has proven to be a very reliable water source and has overfilled some 20 times since that first spill in 1958.

Lake Cachuma can currently hold approximately 188,000-acre feet (AF). Recent alterations to Bradbury Dam have raised the spill elevation to approximately 753 feet above sea level. The recent winter storms have increased Lake Cachuma levels from 724 feet in early January to 747 feet as of January 28 – an increase of 57,500 acrefeet!
