Carpinteria Groundwater Basin Hydrogeologic Update and Groundwater Model Project

Carpinteria Valley Water District has received a score of 86 and a ranking of 21 for it's grant application for the 2007/2008 Local Groundwater Asistance Program administered by the California Department of Water Resources. CVWD's score and ranking indicate that the District will most certainly receive a grant in the amount of \$248,080 to obtain and develop additional hydrogeologic data in order to characterize the Carpinteria groundwater basin and develop a water budget. A "MODFLOW" model application that simulates subsurface conditions will also be developed. The model will be calibrated and then used as a groundwater management tool by simulating pumping scenarios.

The information gained through the hydrogeologic update and model application will illustrate the clear need for monitoring and analysis of groundwater levels and water quality in the Carpinteria Valley Basin. More importantly, the project, along with the District's Ground Water Management Plan (GWMP) will help improve groundwater management, which will facilitate informed decisions regarding the use of the groundwater basin and preserve the integrity and sustainability of groundwater supplies. Some specific examples include determining the "safe yield" of the basin, available storage, the fate of water injected into the basin, and interaction between confined aquifers.

California Hands Free Cell Phone Law
