Projects

A few projects have been taking place around town that have been keeping the District very busy. These projects include a main extension at the new Carl's Jr. restaurant, a main extension to serve a property within Rancho Monte Alegre (RMA) and the relocation of pipe previously under Carpinteria Creek.

The two main extension projects, paid for by the property owners, have increased the District's distribution system by approximately 675 feet of pipe. In addition, two fire hydrants have been installed at these locations.

The pipeline relocation at Carpinteria Creek was part of an environmental restoration effort designed to help in the recovery of steelhead trout. The project was led by **South Coast Habitat**





Restoration with cooperation from the Carpinteria Creek Watershed Coalition. A portion of the project involved removing the District's waterline out of the creek bed and fastening it to a newly installed bridge to keep the line protected.
