Regarding the Budget, Water Rates and Charges

Everyone welcome!

CVWD's May 27th meeting will include a public hearing about the proposed budget, water rates and charges increases for Fiscal Year 2009-2010. The purpose of such adjusted Rates and Charges is to fund the maintenance, operation, repair, construction, and improvement of water facilities of and for the Carpinteria Valley Water District.

The proposed 2009-2010 Budget will increase about 1 percent. The projected monthly bill increase for the average residential customer of the District using 12 units of water is \$2.28 or 2.3 percent.

CVWD's tiered rates vary based on average actual use of water. Please call the District at (805) 684-2816 ext. 117 if you would like to know more specifically how the proposed Rates and Charges increases are likely to affect your monthly bill.

Water Rate Comparison

Listed below are typical monthly bill amounts for water purveyors for the South Coast of Santa Barbara County. The bills reflect usage of 10 and 20 units of water, as of April 2009.

Carpinteria Valley Water District	\$65.57 - \$93.16	\$95.57 - \$133.76
Goleta Water District	\$64.73	\$101.83
Montecito Water District	\$69.95	\$108.95
City of Santa Barbara	\$50.71	\$96.11

CVWD's comparatively high rates reflect the costs of major new facilities to ensure safe drinking water - two large reservoir covers, a new storage tank, and a new well - and State Water costs. The District has recently taken steps to reduce State Water debt, and may succeed with another reduction this year.

CVWD's low end amount reflects customers participating in the District's Lifeline Program. For more information or to see if you qualify, see Lifeline section.
