Eighth Street Bridge Project

The City of Carpinteria's Eighth Street Bridge Project provided the ideal opportunity for the District to remove an old 8" pipe buried underneath Carpinteria Creek and replace it with an 8" pipe attached to the new bridge. The cost of the pipeline replacement was paid by the District.

The position of the new water main allows the District greater accessibility for maintenance and repairs. In addition, it is often difficult to locate leaks in pipelines buried under creek beds due to the inability to see or hear the leak. These types of leaks can go undetected, wasting gallons of water and potentially creating a main break that results in more water lost as well as damage to the surrounding area. The repositioned pipeline along the Eighth Street Bridge decreases the likelihood of such a scenario because leaks will be noticeable to District employees and repaired promptly. It also eliminates the possibility of disturbing the creek and its eco-system.
