

Carpinteria Reservoir Cleaning

The Carpinteria Reservoir recently underwent its tri-annual cleaning. Carpinteria Reservoir, one of two balancing reservoirs on the South Coast Conduit, holds 14 million gallons of water at 380 feet above sea level.

The cleaning is scheduled in winter or early spring because water demand is not as high due to lower temperatures and rain. The reservoir is taken off-line for approximately 1 to 2 weeks while it is cleaned. Prior to being taken offline and cleaning the reservoir, the District draws down the water level to reduce water loss.

The reservoir holds a blend of water from the City of Santa Barbara's Cater Treatment Plant and the Carpinteria Valley's groundwater. Calcium from the water comes out of solution and forms deposits at the bottom. The reservoir's cleaning and removal of deposits reduces the potential for aesthetic water quality issues for both the District and its customers.

Lifeline Customer Assistance Program

If you are enrolled in Southern California Edison's CARE program, you are eligible for the District's Lifeline Customer Assistance Program. The Lifeline Program **reduces the fixed monthly service charge portion** of your water bill by 20%. Simply bring in your Edison bill or gas bill, which indicates that you are a CARE participant (page 3 of Edison bill), to enroll in the District's program. Re-enrollment of the program is required on an annual basis.

Smart Landscape Rebate Program

Get a rebate of up to 50% of the material costs of approved water wise plants, mulch, irrigation equipment including rain sensors and smart controllers! Any combination of irrigation equipment and planting costs may qualify for a one-time, maximum rebate of up to \$500. Projects must be approved in advance and landscapes for new construction are not eligible. Sales receipts are required for all rebates.
