If you oppose the **Rates and Charges increases (as shown in the Notice dated April 1)** please mail your written protest with **original signature** (no facsimiles) to the General Manager/ Secretary of the Carpinteria Valley Water District at 1301 Santa Ynez Avenue, Carpinteria CA 93013, or deliver prior to the close of the Public Hearing held by the Board of Directors at Carpinteria City Hall on July 14, 2010.

All protests received prior to the original May 26, 2010 hearing date will be counted in addition to protests submitted before the end of the public hearing on July 14, 2010. The effect of the continuation of the hearing is to increase the protest filing period from about seven weeks to fifteen weeks. 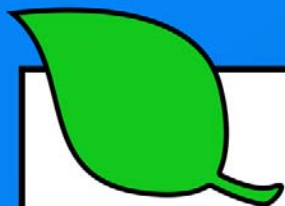
Free Water Check-ups
