While power outages are not always planned, Carpinteria Valley Water District is committed to making every effort to keep its water supply available during power outages caused by storms, earthquakes, accidents, fires or planned outages.

In our efforts to provide water during such emergencies, the Water District has equipped emergency backup generators at all of its major facilities to ensure that the operation of its various pumps and water treatment facilities remain fully functional.

The Operations Department works diligently to ensure that the emergency generators are serviced and tested regularly and that they are all in compliance with the Santa Barbara Air Pollution Control District regulations.
