Central Zone (CZ) Main Project - Phase II In Progress!

Phase II of the Central Zone (CZ) Main Extension Project is underway! The area affected is along El Carro Lane from Sterling Ave to the western end of El Carro Lane. The work began on October 24th and is expected to be completed by mid-December. The benefits of this project, partially funded by a \$2 million Proposition 50 grant, include a centralized pressure zone and improved water quality.



Pictured at left, is the offloading of some of the 12" PVC pipe that will make up the approximately 3000 feet of pipeline for Phase II of the CZ Main Extension Project.

Pictured at right, are the trench markings along El Carro Lane where the pavement will be cut and the pipeline will be installed.
