Central Zone (CZ) Main Construction Coming to a Close



Phase II of the Central Zone Main construction project is coming to a close! The photo at left, shows one of three 36" air vacs recently installed on El Carro Ln. The main purpose of the air vacs is to release trapped air from the water main. The bottom photo shows the old 6" x 12" flanged reducer and valve that will soon be replaced with the new 12" PVC distribution line. Final paving of the street will commence shortly. The purpose and benefits of the CZ Main Project, partially funded by a \$2 million Proposition 50 grant are a centralized pressure zone and improved water quality throughout the Carpinteria area.
