Terminology: Water Budget = Water Allocation

Approach: Individualized Budgets/Allocations

Consumption: Water Use \leq Budget/Allocation

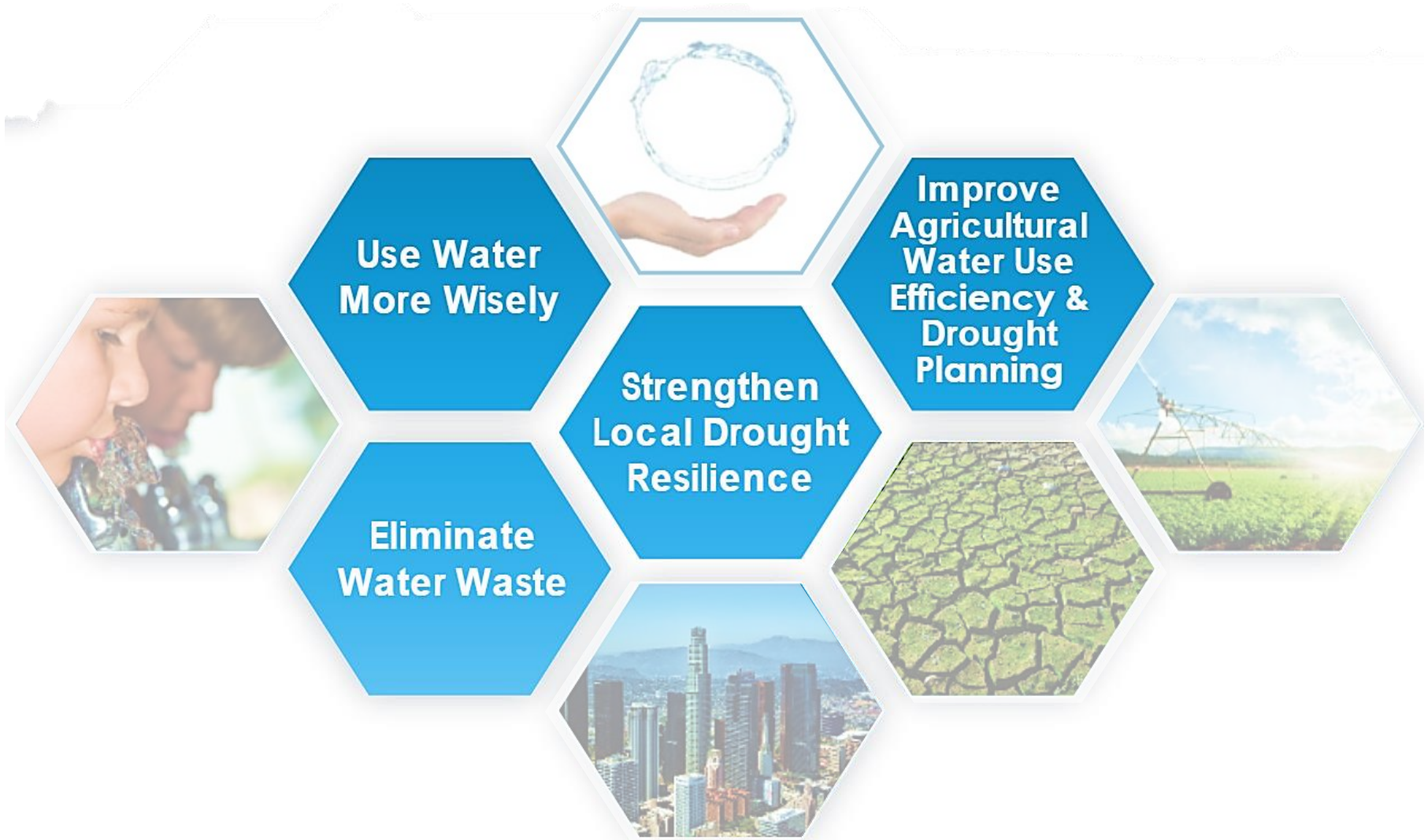


Why do we need an allocation program?



- To **manage water supplies** in times of drought.
- To **provide customers better information** about their water use.
- To **direct conservation** efforts.
- To respond to **development** requests
- To **comply with new State rules**.

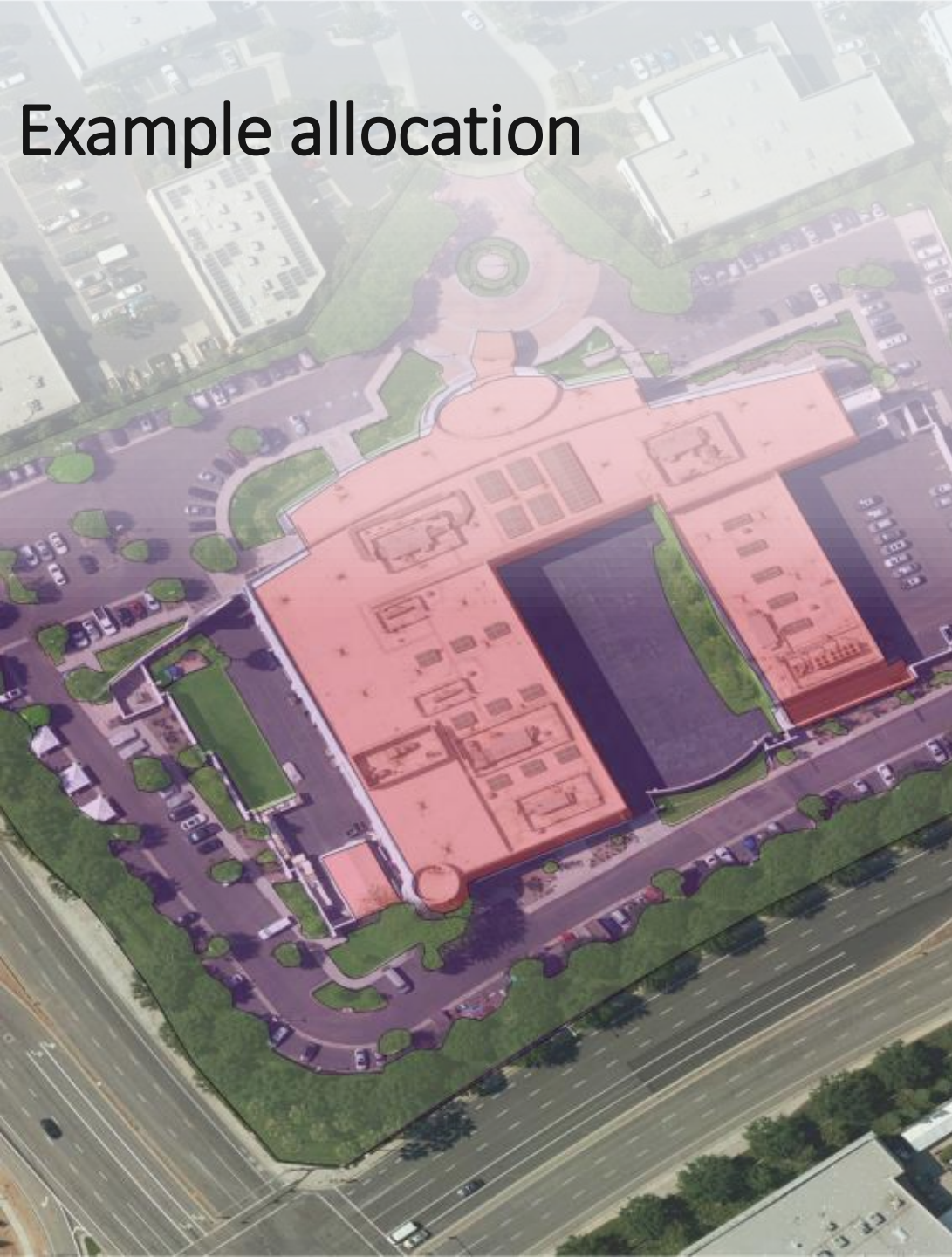

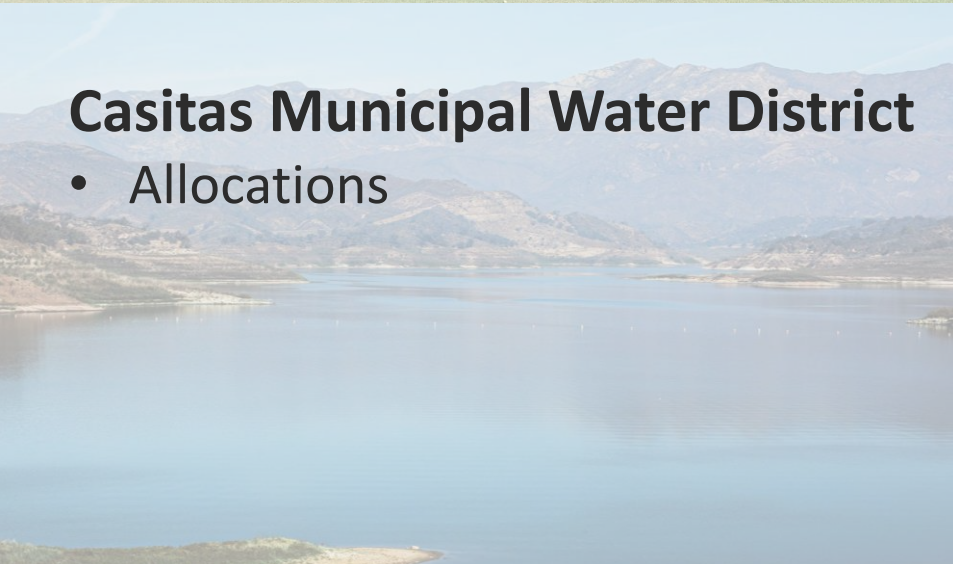

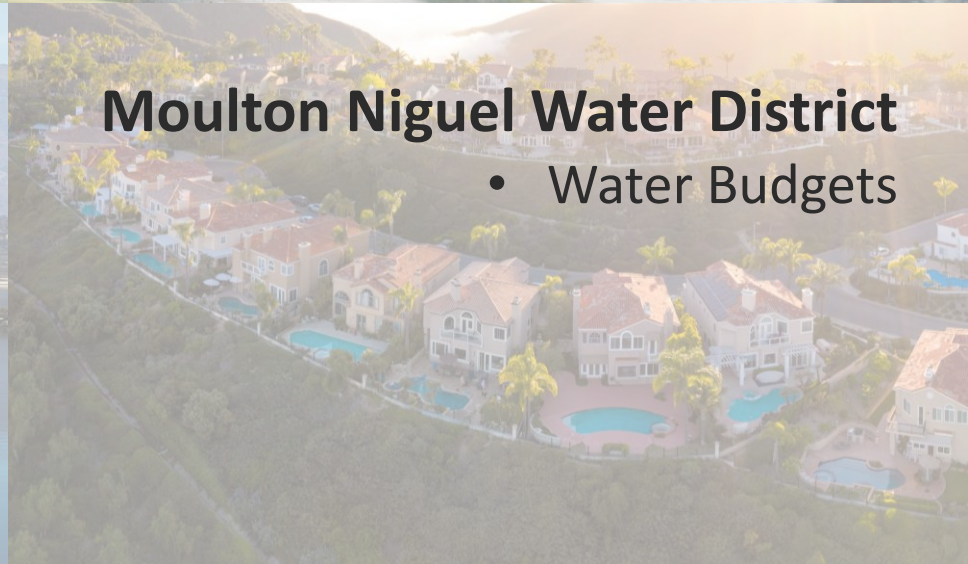
