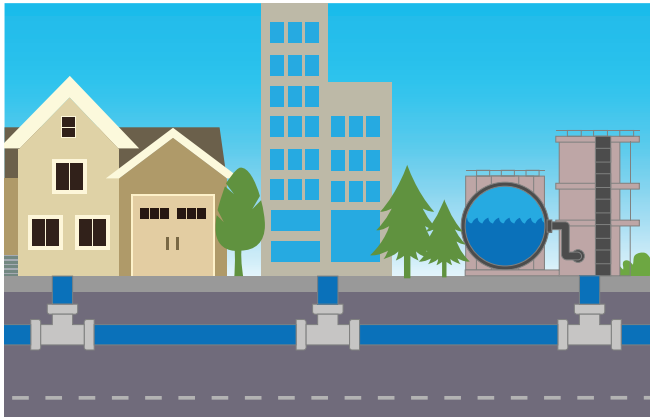

DISCOVER CVWD



CVWD maintains 88 miles of water distribution mainline, 2,356 valves, 450 fire hydrants, 4,431 service connections, 2 ground water wells, 4 booster pump stations, and 4 drinking water reservoirs that serves a population of 15,996 residents.



EXAMPLE OF DUTIES

- Assist with general maintenance and repair of potable and recycled water transmission and distribution systems.
- Perform related water system facilities maintenance and repair work as assigned.
- Install new water meters and meter boxes.
- Assist in collecting and recording water supply and water quality data for mandatory compliance and reporting purposes.
- Operate various types of construction equipment including pneumatic jackhammers or similar equipment to remove dirt, concrete or asphalt.
- Repair/replace leaking angle stop valves.
- Check operation and repair or replace faulty water meters or meter boxes.
- Assist in the operation & maintenance of drinking water wells, booster bump stations and drinking water reservoirs.
- Water quality sampling for CVWD source water wells, throughout the distribution system.
- Perform chlorine residual, iron & manganese testing.

SALARY & BENEFITS
